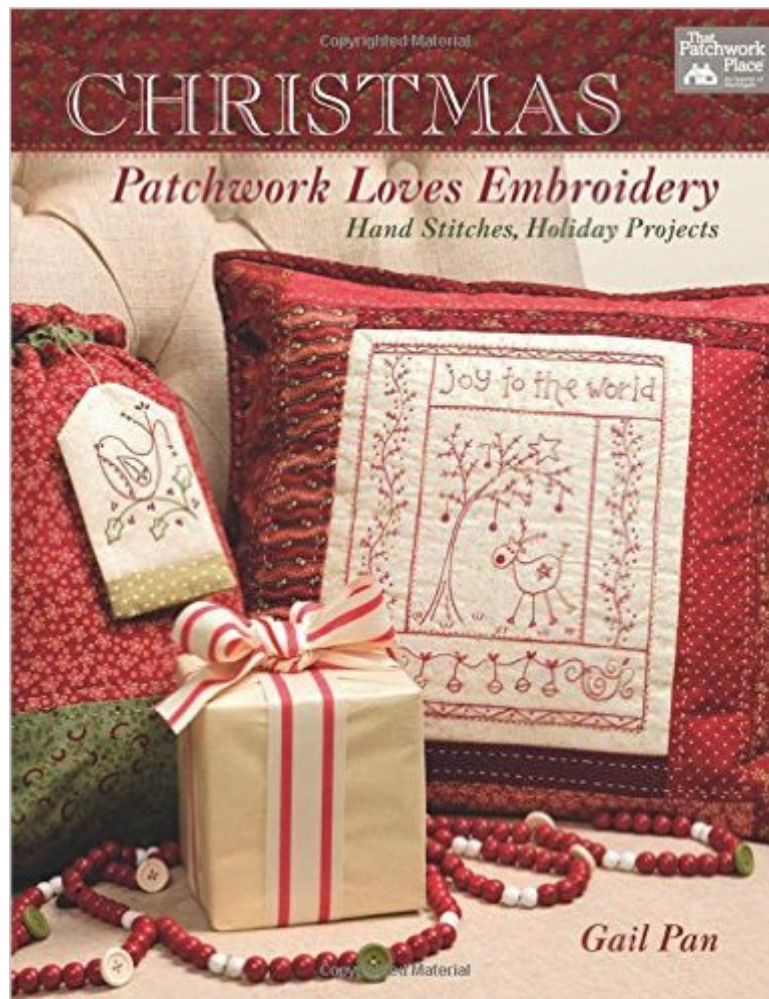

The embroidery patterns could be used on all sorts of projects and simply switch up the color palette of the fabric and these projects would be daring through out the year.

Gail's new book *Christmas Patchwork Loves Embroidery* has been released just in time to start your holiday stitching projects. This book contains 17 charming embroidery designs that you

can use to create gift tags, pillows, wall hangings, table runners, Christmas stockings and more, in fact the author encourages to reader to add these designs to their own projects. The embroidery motifs are printed full size and each contain an embroidery key so you will easily know which stitch is used. Gail does all the works in the book using a warm burgundy, green and yellow color theme but you are free to use whatever colors you choose. General instructions for everything you will need to know can be found at the back of the book. These instructions include information on needles, threads, tracing the design, embroidery fabric and interfacing and hoops. The quilting instructions cover such information as appliqué, batting and quilting. Gail finishes her quilted projects using the big stitch method, which is also explained in the book. The embroidery stitches used are: Backstitch, Chain stitch, Cross stitch, French knot, Lazy Daisy, Running Stitch, Satin stitch, and Stem stitch. Both beginner and advanced stitchers will enjoy this book. These handwork projects will be easy to tuck into your to-go kit and take with you. Soon you will have created some delightful hand-made gifts for family and friends.
